**Job Summary:**

The Agency Outreach Coordinator develops and maintains relationships with partner agencies throughout Ozarks Food Harvest's 28 Missouri counties network, with emphasis on, but not limited to, monitoring, education, technical assistance and program development, in adherence with guidelines developed by Feeding America and Ozarks Food Harvest.

**Main Responsibilities:**

- Conduct site visits to partner agencies to ensure membership compliance.
- Oversee Mobile Food Pantry distributions.
- Participate in quarterly regional meetings, which focus on all areas of the membership agreement, bringing outside resources available to partner agencies and relatable topics that partner agencies are interested in.
- Teach monthly food safety classes to members needing certification in food handling.

**Additional Responsibilities May Include:**

- Actively participate in scheduled Membership Committee and Feeding America network meetings, when possible.
- Network with other social service and food assistance organizations by attending agency and community meetings.

- Attend out-of-town conferences, workshops and other related events to promote continuous quality improvement and evaluate alternative programming.
- Advocate at local, state, and federal levels for hunger relief and poverty.
- Identify underserved communities and counties through research to better serve underprivileged areas.
